

En Passant the Capture

The biggest things to remember with En Passant is that White can only capture En Passant when it is on the 5th rank and Black can only capture En Passant when it is on the 4th rank. Also you can only capture En Passant on the first turn, after that it is illegal.

Diagram 1:

Black has made the move from d3 to d5. White has its pawn on the 5th rank, so based on that info and the info above, it should give a clear answer.

Diagram 2:

Like in Diagram 1, black has played his pawn on the 5th rank, skipping the 6th rank and moving up 2 squares, white has a pawn on the 5th rank. So based on the information above, can White take En Passant?

Diagram 3:

Black has moved it's pawn out to e5, however white only has pawns on the 4th rank. White can capture regularly, but can it capture En Passant?

Diagram 4:

Same position as number 3, white has just played it's pawn to f4, black can capture the pawn regularly, but can it capture it En Passant?

Diagram 5:

White has just played b4, based on the information above, can Black En Passant legally?
