

King's Indian Attack Help Guide

Diagram 1:

White to move. A Fianchetto Bishop playing as White is when you place a Bishop on g2 or b2. A Fianchetto Bishop playing as Black is when you Bishop is on g7 or b7, allowing your Bishop to attack the center from the side.

Diagram 2:

Castling is a great way to get you King safe.

Diagram 3:

A big center is defined by who has more pieces attacking the four center squares.

Diagram 4:

Push a Pawn to attack the b5 square. If its going to protect the b file, is that close to the h file?

Extra Questions:

Generally White will attack the Black at the castled position. Black will attack generally opposite of a castled position.
