

Moves and Values of the Pieces 1

Help Guide

Pawn:

The pawn is worth the least amount of points in the game. In fact, it's number is one more than 0.

Bishop:

This minor piece is worth the second least amount of points. In fact, it's point value is the same as another piece on the board.

Knight:

This piece is worth the same exact amount as another piece on the board. In fact, we have already mentioned it

Rook:

This piece is a very strong piece. So strong that it is worth more points than the Bishop and Knight, but not as much as the queen.

Queen:

Some might say that this piece is the most valuable piece on the board. Keep in mind that it moves just like the Rook and Bishop combined. However if you combine the point values of the Rook and Bishop, it is worth one more point than those combined.

King:

The King is the most valuable piece on the board. In fact, it is so valuable that it can **NEVER** come off the board. There really is no point value for this piece, rather there is a phrase we like to use.
